



- Adana which is the fifth biggest city of Turkey is located in the south part of Turkey. The population is over 2 million.
- The history of Adana starts back in 6000 B.C. This region has become the residential area since Palaelithic Age.
- As it was located in the heart of fertile lands it has been a cradle to many civilizations.

 Çukurova Delta where our city is located lies to the high hills of Taurus mountains from Mediterrenean shores.

- Mediterranean climate is dominant which gains a continental qualifications when we get far from the sea.
- Adana is one of the leading provinces in terms of its number and density of the population, highly increased urbanization and economical growth speed.





- We have 2 fertile rivers the Seyhan and the Ceyhan.
- The agricultural products which have a major role in domestic and foreign trade of Turkey are mostly produced in our region.
- Adana is the marketing and distribution center for Cukurova agricultural region where cotton, wheat, corn, soy beans, barley, grapes and citrus fruits are produced in great quatities.





- Approximately 36 % percent of the soil is seperated for agricultural activities. For this reason the machanization and irrigation is extensively developed.
- We have three universities in our city . One is private the others are public universities.
- There are also a lot of art galleries, theatres, museums, art and science centers.



CULTURE AND ART

- Many international and national celebrities performing all kinds of art were born and lived in Adana.
- We have the most prestigious film festival in Turkey.
 The festival is organized by Adana Metropolitian Municipality every year.
- Orange Flower Festival is celebrated in our city when the citrus flowers blossom. We have a great carnaval and various activities. Many people travel to our city at the time of the carnaval.





EDUCATION IN TURKEY

- Turkish education system is under the supervison and control of the State namely the Ministry of National Education.
- According to our constitution everyone has the right to receive education.
- The education is compulsory from ages 6 to 14 and free in our state schools.
- We have both free state schools and private schools. Both of them are under State control.

- The academic calendar usually starts in mid September and extends through mid-June. The school day usually has morning and afternoon sessions.
- Schools are in sessions for 5 days a week in a total of 35-40 hours. There is a 2 week break between January to February.

• The pupils have 2 exams in every semester. They also have orals given by the teachers according to their performances in the lesson.

• At the end of each semester they get 2 reports regarding their schooling grades.

STAGES OF THE EDUCATION SYSTEM

- Pre-School Education : Optional Kindergarten education for children between 4-6 years age.
- ❖ Primary School Education: Compulsory and free of charge education for 4 years. It is between the ages of 7-11. A foreign language education starts at the second grade.
- Secondary School Education: It is also compulsory and free of charge 4 years. It is between the 11-14. In this part, the students have English lessons.

HIGH SCHOOL EDUCATION

- ❖ High School Education: Students who complete 8 years in education can register various high schools. They have to take enterence exams. This exam is given by the State in order to evaluate their 8 year knowledge in schooling.
- *There are 6 types of high schools. According to the scores they take from the exam they can choose the high schools they want to study.

HIGHER EDUCATION INSTITUTIONS

- The university system in Turkey is governed by the Higher Educational Council. We have got 104 state and 62 private universities.
- Students need to take a nationwide University Entrance Exam to enter university. According to the scores that they get from the exam they can study in the departments that they want.





KASIM SACIDE ENER SECONDARY SCHOOL

- Our school is in the mostly populated District name Seyhan. The students have four year education in our school.
- We have two shifts. The 7th and the 8 the graders come to school in the mornings. The 5th and 6th graders come to school in the afternoon.
- They have 4-6 hours of English language lessons depending on the grades.







STAFF OUR SCHOOL

• We have 1 Headmaster, 4 Vice Principals with 81 teachers.

• We have a total of 1600 students.

 We have two classroom with 100 of kindergarden students. • We have got 22 classrooms equipped with smart boards and a laboratory, a library, a conference room, a teachers room, a big hobby garden ,a counselling room, two kindergarden classrooms, a playground, one football pitch and an art workroom.

- To motivate them by using different techniques in education process to improve the interest in education at school

 To be able to take part in all kinds of projects both on national and international level





ACTIVITIES AT OUR SCHOOL

• We also conduct various Projects both locally and nationwide such as "I eat healthy food" (fighting with obesity), collecting used batteries for a greener world, education of values, thematic painting exhibition with a certain topic every year.

- Every May we have a Science Exhibition where the students conduct many projects with the leadership of their teachers.
- Our art and science and technology teachers have exhibition where they exhibit all the students work of art with a 2 days exhibition in the school garden. It is open to public and other schools as well.
